



ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

The Administration of Camping Arrighi firmly believes in the need to protect the environment in the course of its business activities: it is aware of the need to comply with legislative prescriptions and to reduce to a minimum every significant negative environmental impact. Therefore it aims to develop and maintain procedures for evaluating environmental performance, to search for solutions for reducing environmental impacts to a minimum during normal camping activities and in extraordinary work conditions, involving its personnel and identifying the responsibilities.

The organization proposes to also apply the principles of environmental protection to the choice of suppliers, giving priority to the ecological aspects of the supply.

Continuous improvement is our general guiding principle for the development and growth of environmental performance.

This principle is pursued in line with socio-economic needs, recognizing environmental management as one of the priorities of the organization.

In particular, attention is placed on the optimization of consumption, promoting conservation and controlled use of resources.

Other objectives of the organization include:

- The reduction of potential sources of pollution;
- The reduction and precise control of chemical products used for ordinary maintenance;
- Making clients aware of the importance of environmental protection;
- Recycling;
- Minimizing waste.

All measures to protect the environment must be taken with the conviction that it is not enough to keep environmental issues under control and intervene in case of emergency; instead preventive measures must be introduced through systems for foreseeing environmental impacts.

In fact, during the general renovation of the Campgrounds, environmental protection was at the base of our actions and decisions: this explains the implementation of technologies with a low environmental impact like producing hot water using solar energy, drip irrigation, energy efficient light bulbs, recycling waste produced internally and by our guests. The Administration also intends to ensure that the environmental policy explained here and the corresponding management system are understood, implemented and maintained at all levels of the organization, the system is supported by periodic and systematic instruction and training and that this document is available to the public.

Continuous improvement is our guiding principle.

OUR GUESTS ARE REQUESTED TO COLLABORATE AND OBSERVE A FEW SIMPLE RULES TO HELP MAINTAIN A HIGH STANDARD OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY

1. Water consumption: water is a precious common good. Please avoid wasting water (and do not leave faucets running when not necessary).
2. Sink and shower drains: to prevent pollution, do not pour unsuitable substances into wash basins and sinks (paints and other chemical substances) even in small quantities.
3. Chemical toilets: they must be emptied into the appropriate sewers.
4. Washing cars: cars and RVs may be washed exclusively in the specially equipped area where recycled water is available for this use.
5. Trash: trash must be disposed of in the appropriate recycling bins available in highly visible areas of the campgrounds.
6. Respect for plants: it is forbidden to damage plants, pour boiling or salted water or waste onto the soil.
7. Fires and barbecues: it is forbidden to light fires directly on the ground, the use of grills is allowed only if they do not create hazards or disturb other guests.
8. Hygienic rules: we trust that our guests will collaborate in keeping the campgrounds as clean as possible. Bathroom facilities must be used correctly.
9. Noise: equipment that generates sounds or noise must always be kept at a low volume; during the quiet hours (2:00 – 4:00pm and midnight to 8:00 am) they must be turned off. Motorcycles and scooters must be walked with motors off.
